

Population Demographics




The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **6,551** and changed to **9,571** in 2000, representing a change of **46%**. The household count in 2003 was **10,108** and the household projection for 2008 is **10,948**, a change of **8%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **14,211** and in 2000 it was **19,245**, roughly a **35%** change. The population in 2003 was **20,215** and the projection for 2008 is **21,713** representing a change of **7%**.


In 2003, females represented **52.6**% of the population with a median age of **63.5** and males represented **47.4%** of the population with a median age of **63.1** years.


In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is **65 to 74** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **14 to 17** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity


