## Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics


The number of households in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{6 , 5 5 1}$ and changed to $\mathbf{9 , 5 7 1}$ in 2000, representing a change of $\mathbf{4 6 \%}$. The household count in 2003 was $\mathbf{1 0 , 1 0 8}$ and the household projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{1 0 , 9 4 8}$, a change of $\mathbf{8 \%}$. The population in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{1 4 , 2 1 1}$ and in 2000 it was $\mathbf{1 9 , 2 4 5}$, roughly a 35\% change. The population in 2003 was $\mathbf{2 0 , 2 1 5}$ and the projection for 2008 is 21,713 representing a change of $\mathbf{7 \%}$.

In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was 61.9, and in 2000, it was 65.2. The median age in 2003 is $\mathbf{6 3 . 4}$ and it is predicted to change in five years to $\mathbf{6 1 . 2}$ years.

In 2003, females represented $\mathbf{5 2 . 6} \%$ of the population with a median age of 63.5 and males represented $\mathbf{4 7 . 4 \%}$ of the population with a median age of $\mathbf{6 3 . 1}$ years.

In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is $\mathbf{6 5}$ to 74 years. The age group least represented in this geography is $\mathbf{1 4}$ to $\mathbf{1 7}$ years.
