

Population Demographics



The household count in 2003 was **11,773** and the household projection for 2008 is **13,707**, a change of **16%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **19,152** and in 2000 it was **26,921**, roughly a **41%** change. The population in 2003 was **29,743** and the projection for 2008 is **34,191** representing a change of **15%**.

In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is **35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **14 to 17** years.




Population by Race/Ethnicity
