## Executive Summary Report with Charts

Population Demographics


The number of households in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{8 , 1 0 8}$ and changed to $\mathbf{1 0 , 5 7 5}$ in 2000, representing a change of $\mathbf{3 0 \%}$. The household count in 2003 was 11,773 and the household projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{1 3 , 7 0 7}$, a change of $\mathbf{1 6 \%}$. The population in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{1 9 , 1 5 2}$ and in 2000 it was 26,921, roughly a $\mathbf{4 1 \%}$ change. The population in 2003 was $\mathbf{2 9 , 7 4 3}$ and the projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{3 4 , 1 9 1}$ representing a change of $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$.

Population by Age


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was 46.6, and in 2000, it was 40.7. The median age in 2003 is $\mathbf{4 1 . 5}$ and it is predicted to change in five years to $\mathbf{4 2 . 0}$ years.

In 2003, females represented $\mathbf{5 2 . 1} \%$ of the population with a median age of 43.6 and males represented $\mathbf{4 7 . 9 \%}$ of the population with a median age of $\mathbf{3 9 . 2}$ years.
