Population Demographics


The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 47,509 and changed to 52,423 in 2000, representing a change of $\mathbf{1 0 \%}$. The household count in 2004 was 57,870 and the household projection for 2009 is $\mathbf{6 4 , 4 3 8}$, a change of $\mathbf{1 1 \%}$. The population in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{1 1 6 , 5 4 1}$ and in 2000 it was 125,790, roughly a 8\% change. The population in 2004 was 136,774 and the projection for 2009 is $\mathbf{1 5 0 , 8 1 4}$ representing a change of $\mathbf{1 0 \%}$.

Population by Age


In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was 37.5, and in 2000, it was 39.9. The median age in 2004 is $\mathbf{4 0 . 1}$ and it is predicted to change in five years to 40.0 years.
