


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 47,509 and changed to 52,423 in 2000, representing a change of 10%. The household count in 2004 was 57,870 and the household projection for 2009 is 64,438, a change of 11%. The population in the study area in 1990 was 116,541 and in 2000 it was 125,790, roughly a 8% change. The population in 2004 was 136,774 and the projection for 2009 is 150,814 representing a change of 10%.


In 2004, females represented **51.1**% of the population with a median age of **42.5** and males represented **48.9%** of the population with a median age of **37.8** years.


In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15 to 19** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity




