


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 13,974 and changed to 22,041 in 2000, representing a change of 58%. The household count in 2004 was 24,972 and the household projection for 2009 is 28,678, a change of 15%. The population in the study area in 1990 was 32,358 and in 2000 it was 50,029, roughly a 55% change. The population in 2004 was 55,937 and the projection for 2009 is 63,676 representing a change of 14%.

In 2004, females represented **50.4**% of the population with a median age of **43.7** and males represented **49.6%** of the population with a median age of **39.5** years.


In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **35 to 44** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15 to 19** years.




