


#### **Population Demographics**



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **7,212** and changed to **8,991** in 2000, representing a change of **25%**. The household count in 2004 was **10,126** and the household projection for 2009 is **11,321**, a change of **12%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **16,502** and in 2000 it was **22,127**, roughly a **34%** change. The population in 2004 was **24,637** and the projection for 2009 is **27,350** representing a change of **11%**.

In 2004, females represented **52.0**% of the population with a median age of **44.1** and males represented **48.0%** of the population with a median age of **39.8** years.


In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **5 to 14** years. The age group least represented in this geography is **18 to 24** years.



#### Population by Race/Ethnicity






