


Population Demographics



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 23,671 and changed to 34,265 in 2000, representing a change of 45%. The household count in 2003 was 38,028 and the household projection for 2008 is 43,897, a change of 15%. The population in the study area in 1990 was 55,011 and in 2000 it was 76,614, roughly a 39% change. The population in 2003 was 84,545 and the projection for 2008 is 96,644 representing a change of 14%.


In 2003, females represented **52.0**% of the population with a median age of **48.5** and males represented **48.0**% of the population with a median age of **44.2** years.


In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is **75** + years. The age group least represented in this geography is **14 to 17** years.

Population by Race/Ethnicity


