Population Demographics


The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 23,671 and changed to $\mathbf{3 4}, 265$ in 2000, representing a change of $\mathbf{4 5} \%$. The household count in 2003 was $\mathbf{3 8 , 0 2 8}$ and the household projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{4 3 , 8 9 7}$, a change of $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$. The population in the study area in 1990 was $\mathbf{5 5 , 0 1 1}$ and in 2000 it was $\mathbf{7 6}, \mathbf{6 1 4}$, roughly a $\mathbf{3 9 \%}$ change. The population in 2003 was $\mathbf{8 4}, \mathbf{5 4 5}$ and the projection for 2008 is $\mathbf{9 6 , 6 4 4}$ representing a change of $\mathbf{1 4 \%}$.
