


**Population Demographics** 



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was 2,955 and changed to **4,393** in 2000, representing a change of **49%**. The household count in 2003 was 4,439 and the household projection for 2008 is 4,508, a change of 2%. The population in the study area in 1990 was 8,771 and in 2000 it was 15,076, roughly a 72% change. The population in 2003 was 15,355 and the projection for 2008 is 15,773 representing a change of 3%.

**Population by Age** 



In 1990, the median age of the total population in the study area was 33.1, and in 2000, it was 29.6. The median age in 2003 is 30.5 and it is predicted to change in five years to 32.4 years.

In 2003, females represented 43.7% of the population with a median age of 32.5 and males represented 56.3% of the population with a median age of **29.6** years.

In 2003, the most prominent age group in this geography is 25 to 34 years. The age group least represented in this geography is 75 + years.



**Population by Race/Ethnicity** 




