


#### **Population Demographics**



The number of households in the study area in 1990 was **27,970** and changed to **38,212** in 2000, representing a change of **37%**. The household count in 2004 was **43,167** and the household projection for 2009 is **49,278**, a change of **14%**. The population in the study area in 1990 was **64,126** and in 2000 it was **85,207**, roughly a **33%** change. The population in 2004 was **95,144** and the projection for 2009 is **107,679** representing a change of **13%**.

In 2004, females represented **51.6**% of the population with a median age of **47.2** and males represented **48.4%** of the population with a median age of **42.7** years.


In 2004, the most prominent age group in this geography is **75** + years. The age group least represented in this geography is **15** to **19** years.




